
19/00164/AGFO Erection of agricultural building at Barton Houes, Barton. Decision: Prior approval not required as qualifies as an AGFO.

18/04873/FUL and 18/04874/LBC New dormer windows at Stable Cottage, Ford. 'No objection' posted. Awaiting decision.

19/00813/FUL and 19/00814/LBC The Manor, Temple Guiting. Repair and restoration of existing garage outbuildings and conversion into estate office. Erection of new gardener's bothy. Site visit 1 April. Councillors' concerns regarding use of a painted corrugated metal roof on a traditional stone and oak panelled building posted to CDC planning portal, including request to make the use of traditional Cotswold stone slates a condition of permitting the application. Awaiting decision.


