

What’s hot and what’s not in your home



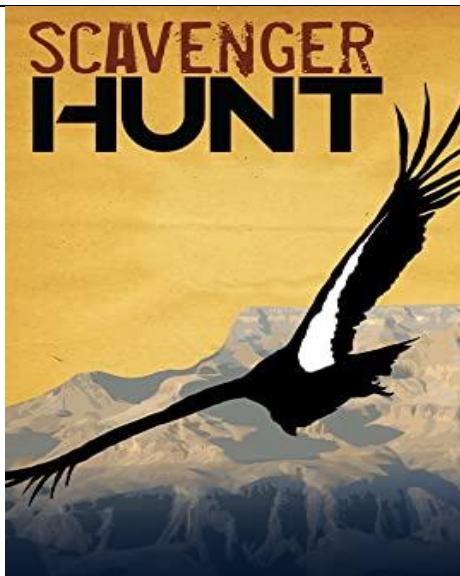
