Minutes of the Annual Temple Guiting Parish Council Meeting

Held on Wednesday 6th May 2026 at 7.00 p.m. in the village hall.

Councillors present: Lorna Eayrs, Jayne Ewart-Perks, Michael Krier, Kate Mather (Chairman), Mickey Morrissey (Vice Chairman)

Public: 6 members of the public attended.

- 1. Election of Chairman for 2026/27.** Cllr Krier proposed and Cllr Morrissey seconded Cllr Mather as Chairman for the new financial year. Cllr Mather accepted and signed the Declaration of Acceptance.
- 2. Election of Vice Chairman for 2026/27.** Cllr Ewart-Perks proposed and Cllr Eayrs seconded Cllr Morrissey as Vice Chairman for the new financial year. Cllr Morrissey accepted and signed the Declaration of Acceptance.
- 3. Apologies for absence.** None
- 4. Declarations of interest in items on the Agenda (Localism Act 2011):** None.
- 5. Points from the floor:** A resident noted that construction traffic for New Barn Farm was inappropriate for the local roads and that part of the wall before the bridge had been damaged at a high level i.e. was likely to have been caused by a lorry. However, the construction traffic was essential to the site works.
- 6. Chairman's announcements.** The Chairman reported that Cllr Hanks had resigned due to excessive workload and that she had accepted her resignation. She thanked Liza Hanks for her commitment. The water testing that Liza had carried out would not be continued as the results showed very little pollution over the year.

The Chairman noted that the solar panel for the VAS at Ford needed cleaning and Cllr Wilson agree to do this while the road was closed due to bridge repair works.
- 7. Minutes of the previous meeting.** Councillors approved the minutes of the previous meeting and the Chairman signed them. **Action: Clerk to post to the website.**
- 8. Training** Three councillors had completed the GDPR training. The remaining councillors could not find the link to the training course. **Action: Clerk to ask the provider to resend the links.**
- 9. Membership of GALC.** Councillors decided to renew membership for 2026 27. **Action: Clerk to arrange payment and notify GALC.**
- 10. Quarry traffic monitoring.** Councillor Ewart-Perks outlined the need for monitoring and the opportunity for funding from the GCC Grassroots Neighbourhood Fund. Councillors agreed to apply for funding. At meeting in Toddington with representatives from GCC Minerals and Highways, GCC revealed that it had no traffic data for the B4077. Cameras would provide the data required at a cost of £2000 for 5 monitoring cameras. Representatives of Oathill Quarry offered a donation if required. **Action: Clerk to complete submission.**
- 11. Traffic incidents at Trafalgar Cross on the B4077.** Councillors noted the recent fatal accident at the crossroads of the B4077 and Buckle Street. As there is no power in that

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location traffic lights were not an option. **Action: Clerk to write to police and Highways asking for action on this dangerous crossing.**

12. Governance. Councillors reviewed and approved the following:

- a) Standing orders
- b) Asset Register
- c) Financial Regulations.
- d) Code of Conduct

Action: Clerk to update website.

- e) GDPR form – confirming that Councillors have checked that they only hold appropriate data. Councillors signed the declaration.
- f) VH Trustee dispensation form – giving Councillors who are also trustees of a charity a dispensation to speak on the basis that their contribution is relevant. Councillors agreed to give a dispensation to Village Hall/Recreation ground trustee councillors.

13. AGAR - Certificate of Exemption from external audit (AGAR 2025/6 Form 2). Councillor approved the certificate. **Action: Clerk to update website.**
